New warrant docket court to be offered by Municipal Judge

WEATHERFORD (CITY OF WEATHERFORD), Texas — The City of Weatherford Municipal Judge is introducing new Warrant Docket Court beginning Aug. 28 at 12 p.m. in Weatherford City Hall.

The new Warrant Docket Court will offer defendants with a Weatherford Class C misdemeanor an opportunity to go before the Municipal Judge without concern of being arrested. Defendants will also have the opportunity to avoid the expense and hardship of posting bond. For a warrant to be lifted, defendants will be required to pay a \$100 payment per warrant. The Municipal Judge will offer an extension to pay remaining balance(s) regarding an offense to individuals who may have a financial hardship.

“It’s a great opportunity for a defendant to appear on their lunch break and resolve any outstanding warrant by allowing a low down payment with affordable monthly payments,” said Judge Robert T. Galbreath.

The Warrant Docket Court is scheduled at noon on the last day Friday of each month to accommodate defendants who cannot attend court during normal business hours. A Spanish speaking clerk will be made available in the Courtroom to assist with communication needs.
