Code of Fair Campaign Practices (voluntary) and Appointment of a Campaign Treasurer forms are normally submitted at this time. • First day to declare Write-In. • Last day for timely filing of semi-annual report of contributions and expenditures |

| January 29, 2020 | Post Notice of General Election on Bulletin Board |
| February 14, 2020 | Last day to file application for place on ballot 5:00 p.m. |
| February 18, 2020 | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Last day to declare write-in candidacy. • Post on Bulletin Board the Notice of Drawing for places on the ballot |
| February 19, 2020 | If no candidate has an opponent, deliver certification of unopposed candidate(s) to the City Council (at next meeting on 2/25) |
| February 21, 2020 | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Last day for ballot candidate to withdraw- 5:00 p.m. • Last day for write-in candidate to withdraw- 5:00 p.m. • Drawing for places on the ballot – 5:05 p.m. • Send Ballot Language and Notice of Election to County Clerk and Voter Registrar |
| March 13, 2020 | Begin period of mandatory office hrs for CSO (min 3 hr/day on regular business days) |
| April 2, 2020 | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 30-day before report due: 1st Campaign report of expenditures and contributions due by opposed candidates and not using “modified reporting” – 5:00 p.m. • Last day to register to vote in May 2, 2020 election • Request list of registered voters in City of Weatherford • Send notice of election to newspaper for publication at least once (April 2-22) |
| April 11, 2020 | Publication of Notice of Election (in today’s paper) |
| April 15, 2020 | Last day to begin posting continuous notice of schedule for branch early voting places (post when received from County Elections) |
| April 20, 2020 | First day of early voting Last day to receive application for voting by mail |
| April 24, 2020 | 8-day before report due: 2nd Campaign report of expenditures and contributions due by opposed candidates and not using “modified reporting” – 5:00 p.m. |
| April 28, 2020 | Last day of early voting |
| May 1, 2020 | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Obtain list of registered voters • Post notice of meeting to conduct Canvass of the votes |
| May 2, 2020 | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Election Day 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m. • Receive unofficial tabulation of results from the County |
| May 5, 2020 | Provide official statement of elected officer not appointed by the governor and oath of office to candidates who appear to have won, or may win. (just provide—signing occurs after the canvass) |
| May 12, 2020** | County Elections Office expects to have canvass report ready at 12:00 noon today **TENTATIVE based on dates for canvass report for previous elections. |
| May 12, 2020 | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Official Canvass of the votes; Election Certificates Issued; Oaths of Office (must occur May 7-15) • First meeting of newly sworn officials @ Regular City Council Meeting 6:30 p.m. |
| May 10-18, 2020 | Period to order runoff election (if needed; but must be ordered not later than 5 th day after canvass) |
| May 25-Jun 29, 2020 | Possible period for runoff election (if needed) (must be agreed upon with Elections Office) |
| June 1, 2020 | Last day to send precinct voting results to the Secretary of State |
| June 11, 2020 | End period of mandatory office hours for CSO |
| July 15, 2020 | Semi-Annual Statements due from Office Holders and Candidates if Final Report not completed – 5:00 p.m. |
