### Energy Saving Tips Help Keep Consumption Low in Your Home

- AIR-CONDITIONER—Replace air filters monthly for maximum airflow and benefit.
- APPLIANCES—When not in use, turn off and unplug appliances, lights and equipment.
- COMPACT FLUORESCENT LIGHTS—Use compact fluorescent lights (CFLs) with the Energy Star Label.
- DISHWASHER—Run your dishwasher only when fully loaded, turn off the heated drying cycle and air dry dishes.
- ELECTRONIC DEVICES—Unplug electronics and turn off computers and printers at the power strip when not in use.
- INSULATION—Add insulation and/or a better quality insulation to your home.
- LAUNDRY—Do laundry efficiently by using the warm or cold water setting for washing clothes, always use cold water to rinse.
- LEAKS—Weather-strip, seal and caulk leaky doors and windows, and install foam gaskets behind outlet covers.
- MICROWAVE—Use a microwave when possible, it uses two-thirds less energy than a stove.
- REFRIGERATOR—A full refrigerator works less to keep items cooler when the door is open.
- THERMOSTAT—Install a programmable thermostat to control the temperature.
- WATER HEATER—Set your hot water heater thermostat at 120° Fahrenheit.
